ALBERGUE INSPIRA



Location

Santiago de Surco - Lima

Community context

Santiago de Surco is located in Lima Downtown. It is a quiet district, and the citizen security is one of its main attributes.

Type of project

Children, teenagers, and assistance of risk population.

Hosting situation

Host family

Aims of the project

“La Casita de la Paz” provides a safe environment for children and teenagers that are coming to Lima to have cancer treatment, burn treatment, brain paralysis or Down’s syndrome therapies.

ALBERGUE INSPIRA

Project activities

“La Casita de la Paz” offers a place to rest before and after medical intervention or therapies. Most beneficiaries come from rural areas or Indigenous Communities. Thus, the beneficiaries and their companions will be provided with hosting, and also, have access to food and workshops during their stay. While beneficiaries are receiving their respective treatment, the project will help the companions to settle down in the city.

Volunteer’s requirements

Speak basic Spanish and have artistic skills. The volunteer has to be altruistic, initiative-taking and organized.

Volunteer’s tasks

The volunteer will have to help in different activities: help the administrative team, manage the storages, manage the donations, take care of children, outside workshops with the children, help to prepare food, and with the promotion of the house on social media. This will depend on their motivation, but they are allowed to start their own projects in the house.



ASOCIACIÓN MUNDO LIBRE



Location

Pachacamac, Lima - Peru

Community context

The project is located in a rural area in the southeast of Lima. It is an hour away from the center.

Type of project

Host center for children

Hosting situation

Host family

Aims of the project

Mundo Libre provides a safe environment for children and adolescents who have been homeless or who come from violent environments. One of Mundo Libre's goals is to restore the dignity and values that children lost by being homeless, through the consequences of drugs, sexual exploitation, violence and more. In this way, they will be able to return to society.

ASOCIACIÓN MUNDO LIBRE

Project activities

Mundo libre offers spaces for psychological therapy, academic workshops, health assistance and spirituality centers. The project welcomes more than forty children between the ages of 9 and 17.

Volunteer's requirements

The volunteer must be at least 18 years old and have intermediate Spanish knowledge. They should have experience working with children. Artistic skills are desirable.

Volunteer's tasks

The volunteers will have to help in different areas: health, administrative and social work. Volunteers will receive training and based on their skills, will be assigned to a specific area. During their time on the project, they will take on more responsibilities as volunteers gain a deeper understanding of the needs and activities requiredd



LA COMPAÑIA



Location

Jesus Maria, Lima - Perú

Community context

The project is located in an rural area, in one of the districts of the center of Lima.

Type of project

Educational, social support, children and teenagers

Hosting situation

Host family

Aims of the project

To offer educational and recreational workshops to the children and teenagers that are hospitalized or that are in the intensive care unit. The purpose is to help the children to keep studying, smiling and learning.

LA COMPAÑIA

Project activities

La Compañia is carrying out educational workshops to the children that are in the hospital, as well, they are preparing workshops so the children can participate of recreational activities while staying in there.

Volunteer's requirements

The volunteer must be at least 18 years old, also must be open to work in different environments as the hospital has children from different backgrounds. It is important that the volunteer will be able to comply with bio security measures.

Volunteer's tasks

The volunteers will work directly with the children, medical team, nurses, families and local team. After a training, the volunteer will carry out his/her owns workshops with 6 to 12 children.



CASA RONALD MCDONALD PERÚ



Location

This project will have two houses: one located in Jesús María district (Casa Essalud) and the second one in Santiago de Surco district (Casa San Gabriel "Carla Salazar")

Community context

Santiago de Surco and Jesus Maria are urban districts located in the center of Lima, both of them are known for being quiet and calm districts.

Type of project

Risk, health and education on children and teenagers

Hosting situation

Host family

Aims of the project

The houses will provide a safe environment for rural children and teenagers that are coming to Lima to receive health treatments, most of them related with oncological cases, heart problems or complicate diseases.

CASA RONALD MCDONALD PERÚ

Project activities

To provide a house for those that do not have a place while receiving treatment. It is a place where the children and their companions can rest, receive food and educational workshops.

Volunteer's requirements

Basic knowledge of Spanish. The volunteer will have to be proactive and organized, as well it will be important if the volunteer has experience working with a team and children.

Volunteer's tasks

Volunteers will be on charge of the following responsibilities:

1. Assist in daily activities related to the home such as helping in the kitchen, keeping track and reporting on the stock of donations, taking care of children and families, etc.
2. Be part of social events and support those with the team in charge of the organization (sponsorship galas, fundraising events, social workshops, etc).
3. Be part of the internal educational workshops, prepare them and carry them out. Prepare games and recreational activities for children.
4. Assist in local programs organizing schedules, carrying out a control and reporting of the activities of volunteers, children and companions. Also carry out the logistics of the workshops.





CALLAO

HOGAR POSADA DE BELÉN



Location

Callao, Callao - Peru

Community context

Hogar Posada de Belen is located at the center of Callao, near to Peru's most important port. It is a city with social conflicts.

Type of project

Host center for children

Aims of the project

The project houses school children who have been abandoned, giving them a safe place to grow up away from gangs. In addition, it provides a good environment so that they can feel love and tranquility. They have ample spaces for family reunification and offer workshops on the importance of the family. They emphasize the importance of Christianity and show solidarity with children and families so that they can have support in tough times and overcome them.

Living in the project/host family

HOGAR POSADA DE BELÉN

Project activities

The project has activities such as: teaching children to pray and find guidance on Christianity, academic counseling, providing academic material and spaces to study, providing quality food, health services and medications, psychological assistance and workshops, recreational spaces, and create cultural spaces. Likewise, they encourage dialogue and training seminars for parents.

Volunteer's requirements

The volunteer should be at least 18 years old, have intermediate Spanish knowledge and experience working with children.

Volunteer's tasks

The volunteer will be an academic help by giving workshops or helping the children with their homework, as well as being part of the daily activities such as playing with the children, preparing food, cleaning and more. They will also manage the social networks of the project.



COMUNIDAD SAGRADA FAMILIA



Location

Ventanilla – Callao

Community context

Ventanilla is located at the north of Callao.

Type of project

Education and health assistance for risk population.
Specially children and teenagers.

Hosting situation

Living with the children in the community city,
volunteers flat and host family

Aims of the project

The project is a community city that supports underage children who have been abandoned or have been living in a situation of risk. The community provides a safe environment in which children have access to health services, education, housing, and food.

COMUNIDAD SAGRADA FAMILIA



Project activities

Children have access to a school, a health center, apartments and more. Housed children receive these services, while outpatient children come to receive education at the school. They house around two hundred children and expand their services to around 1,200 outpatient children.

Volunteer's requirements

Spanish knowledge is desirable. The volunteer has to be open to live in a community environment and share spaces with the children.

Volunteer's tasks

Volunteers will be able to assist in different areas depending on their abilities or desires:

- Teaching: primary school, math, sociology, languages.
- Social work: taking care of the children, assisting them in homework, evaluating social situations, and more
- Artistical or sporting workshops
- Administrative work, managing communication and design
- Technical workshops: music, wood making, mechanic, and more
- Collaborating with the team to build or maintain the city.
